SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT - REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

PROPOSAL INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

I. Invitation and Project Brief

The City of Ferndale would like to invite qualified bids for upcoming sewer rehabilitation work. Using a sewer camera, 13 locations within the City's sewer system have been identified as requiring repairs (please refer to map showing locations of needed repairs). Infiltration from seasonally high groundwater is leaking into the system. The City is seeking a qualified contractor that is able to provide a trenchless method for point repairs and patches within the system. A description of the source of infiltration is described in Table 1. All work shall be in conformance with the City of Ferndale Encroachment Permit requirements (see attached Encroachment Permit Application), The City of Ferndale Standard Plans and Specifications, and the State of California Department of Transportation 2006 Standard plans, plan updates, and standard specifications as applicable. The successful bidder shall obtain an encroachment permit from the City of Ferndale prior to the start of work.

II. Submission Requirements

1. Identification of Company
 - a. Name and Address of Company
 - b. Contact information of company and name of principal contact
2. Timeline for completion of work
Include all tasks necessary to complete repairs.
3. Representative Projects
Please list at least three projects completed by your company that are of a similar nature to the work requested by this RFP.
4. References
Please list three references that can be contacted who are knowledgeable of your company's work product.
5. Fee proposal
Please provide a lump sum proposal for sites 1 – 10, 12 and 13, with a separate proposal for site 11. Site 11 is a repair of the lateral. The City may choose to plug this lateral from the main.

III. Method of Selection

Selection will be based upon:

- Qualifications
- Experience on similar projects
- Cost-effectiveness
- Timeline for work completion

IV. Submission
